

Teach-Pair-Share

A Greenheart Grant for Paired American & International Teachers

In celebration of International Education Week, the new Teach-Pair-Share grant provides up to \$1000 for Greenheart teachers collaborating with a local colleague on a project that benefits their students, school, and broader community. For example, you might <u>organize a language-immersion day</u>, update laboratory equipment and lesson plans to improve student learning, or create an educational garden. Submit your application to <u>bwashick@greenheart.org</u> by January 1, 2019.

Eligibility:

- Requires a **co-applicant team** comprised of either:
 - 1. A Greenheart Exchange Teach USA teacher + an American teacher working at the same school during the 2018-2019 academic year.
 - 2. An American Greenheart Travel teacher + an international teacher working at the same school abroad during the 2018-2019 academic year.
- Design a project that benefits both teachers' students.
- Commit to complete your project by June 30, 2019.
- Commit to submit a progress report, including original content (e.g., photos) documenting part of your collaborative process by April 20, 2019.
