A Greenheart Grant for Paired American & International Teachers

In celebration of International Education Week, the new Teach-Pair-Share grant provides up to \$1000 for Greenheart teachers collaborating with a local colleague on a project that benefits their students, school, and broader community. For example, you might [organize a language-immersion day](#), update laboratory equipment and lesson plans to improve student learning, or create an educational garden. Submit your application to [bwashick@greenheart.org](mailto:bwashick@greenheart.org) by January 1, 2019.

## Eligibility:

- Requires a **co-applicant team** comprised of either:
  1. A Greenheart Exchange Teach USA teacher + an American teacher working at the same school during the 2018-2019 academic year.
  2. An American Greenheart Travel teacher + an international teacher working at the same school abroad during the 2018-2019 academic year.
- Design a project that benefits both teachers' students.
- Commit to **complete your project by June 30, 2019**.
- Commit to submit a progress report, including original content (e.g., photos) documenting part of your collaborative process by **April 20, 2019**.
